How to use your 10 Photoshop Actions

Once you have downloaded the 'dcm267-files.zip' file to your computer, extract it and put the downloaded folders somewhere they can be located easily.

1 OPEN PHOTOSHOP

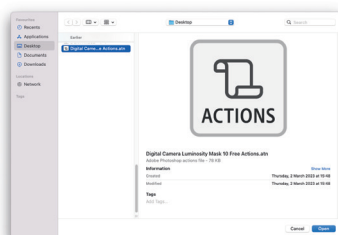
We're using Adobe Photoshop CC, the desktop version of Adobe's popular image editing and creative software.

2 CLICK IMPORT

In the Actions palette (Window > Actions) in the top right, click on Load Actions.

3 SELECT THE FILES

Navigate to the 'Photoshop Actions' folder, then select the file called Luminosity Mask 10 Free Actions.atn and load it.

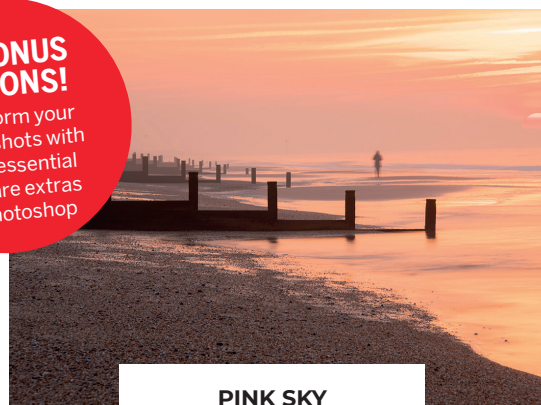
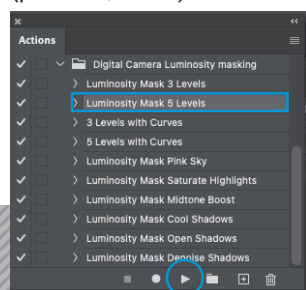


4 EXPAND THE MENU

The 10 Actions will have been imported into Photoshop into the Actions palette.

5 VIEW THE ACTIONS

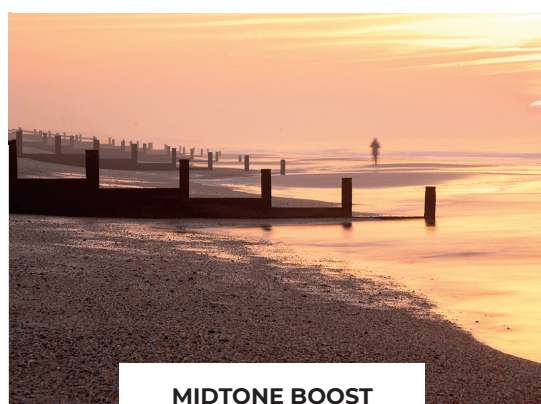
The file names of the Actions are now visible. With an image displayed in Photoshop, click on an action you'd like to apply, and press the play button (pictured, below).

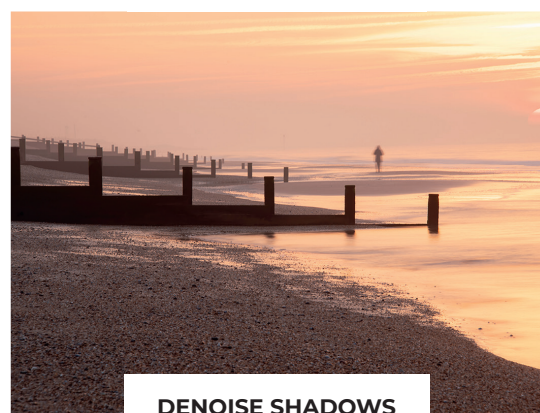

Photoshop Luminosity masking actions

Make selective tonal adjustments in just a few clicks with these time-saving software extras



Luminosity masking is a powerful technique for making selective tonal adjustments; it offers a fine degree of control over the brightness of different tonal ranges within a scene. We are giving away a pack of 10 Luminosity masking actions for you to use with your images. Applying them will allow you to create selections of different

areas of brightness in a scene and then enhance those areas with simple adjustments. Ten Photoshop Luminosity masking actions can be found in the pack. The initial actions will let you create either three or five levels of luminosity channels, either with or without Curves layers for each, while several of the other actions let you apply specific edits, like shifting the colours in a sky to make it more pink.
