You're on your way to having a really cool interactive pdf portfolio that will impress your clients or potential clients!

### Fonts

As per GraphicRiver standards, fonts and screenshot assets cannot be provided with this download. The fonts used within this file are either system fonts or free fonts. The system fonts are Georgia and Verdana. The free font used in the header and project numbers can be downloaded at the following location...

The assets that use Alte Haas Grotesk are placed inside the InDesign document. In order to modify these you will need to have Adobe Illustrator. Change the title "The Bizness" to read however you like in Adobe Illustrator and update the file in InDesign.

### Main Navigation

The main navigation (Portfolio, Case Study and Contact) can be changed to read however you like. To modify it, simply use the Type Tool to select the text and type the new page name. You will need to change the text for both the normal and hover state of the button. Look in the Buttons Palette (Window > Interactive > Buttons) select the hover state and make the text change to the navigation there as well.

### Linking the buttons 1-5 (the header)

The buttons 1-5 at the beginning of the document change to show a new work sample once you click on them. The fastest way to change those images is to overwrite the linked files that comprise those images. You can also change these images inside the InDesign document. To do this, select the image you'd like to change and go to File > place to select your new image. Note samples 2-5 are on separate layers with visibility turned off to make it easy to see what you're doing.

### Linking the other projects and text links to a website

Simply select the button, go to Window > Interactive > Buttons then change the URL of where the button links to. Again, if you change the text links (that have a hover state) to read differently, you will need to modify the normal and hover state of the button.



## Character Styles

The Character Styles palette has styles defined for almost all of the text. Look here to change the color and style of certain text elements to do it efficiently and with ease.

## Background Color and Footer

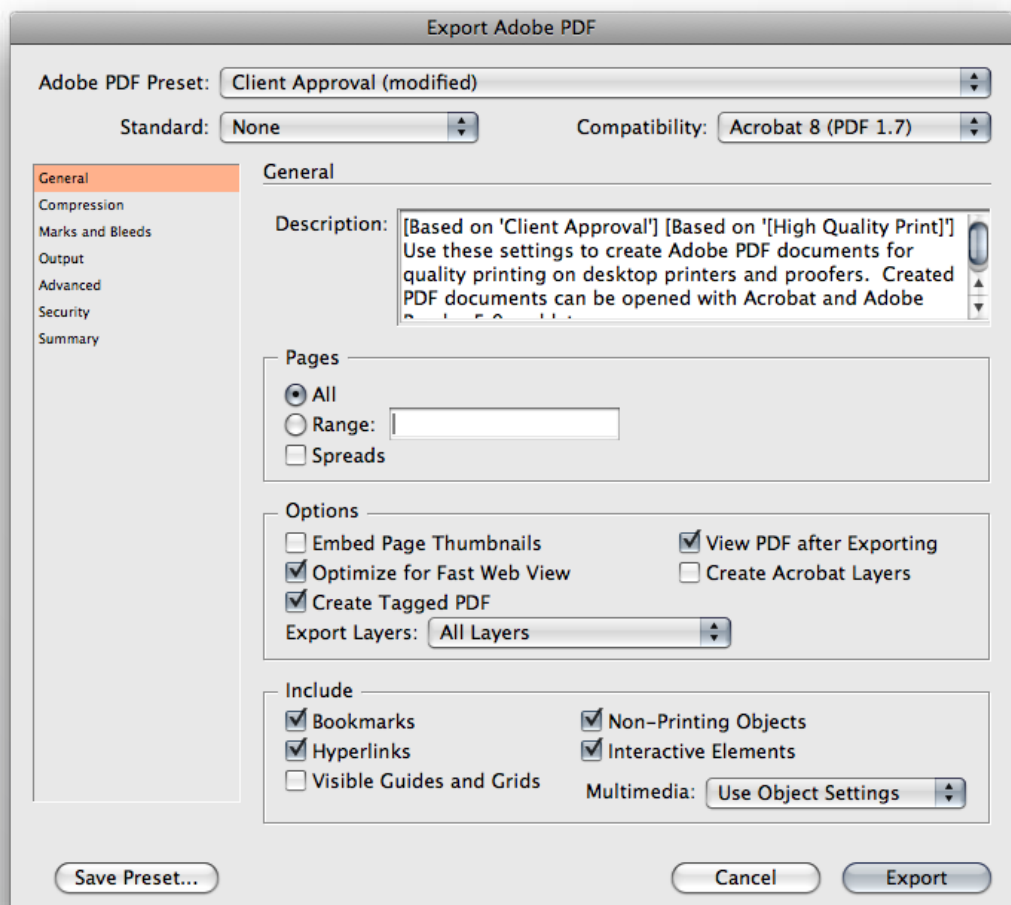
The background color and footer are on a Master Page since these items are consistent across all pages of the document. Change the items on the master page and they will update throughout the document.

## Color Shifting

The colors will shift when you export them from InDesign to pdf form. The colors that you see in the pdf are the intended colors. Don't pay too much attention to what the colors look like while in InDesign as the person who gets the pdf will see it how you intended.

## Making an Interactive PDF

Go to File > Export and select pdf then Save. Use the settings below to ensure that all your interactive elements work.
