# **Mock-up Master**

This file will teach you how to use the display documents and get a nice presentation of your designs with one action click!

# **Layers panoramic (same for all the files)**

Background	Background: Original image

#### **Sizes**

**Mock-up**: 2560×1600px RGB 300DPI **Template**: 1020x1020px RGB 72DPI **Central display size**: 1020×1020px

#### **Documents order**

Very important is the right sequence when you open the documents! When I created the action, I made Photoshop to interact with the file next to the mock-up. The right sequence is:

MOCK-UP -> TEMPLATE

### How to use the file

Let's start!

First of all, have a look of the template file.

Move on <u>template.psd</u> and add your desidered design to the empty layers. Note that if you are going to replace only few displays, however you must fill all the layers with at least one colour (white could be the best choice to preserve the focus on the central images).

Load in Photoshop the action I included in the source directory. Open the panel if is not already showed up.

Move on the mock-up and click the action called "Replace diplays".

## **Important!**

- Do not modify the visibility of any layers.
- Before to load the action, all the layers MUST be deselected.

Once you have clicked the button, wait the end of the operation. This time it only needs few seconds! :)
