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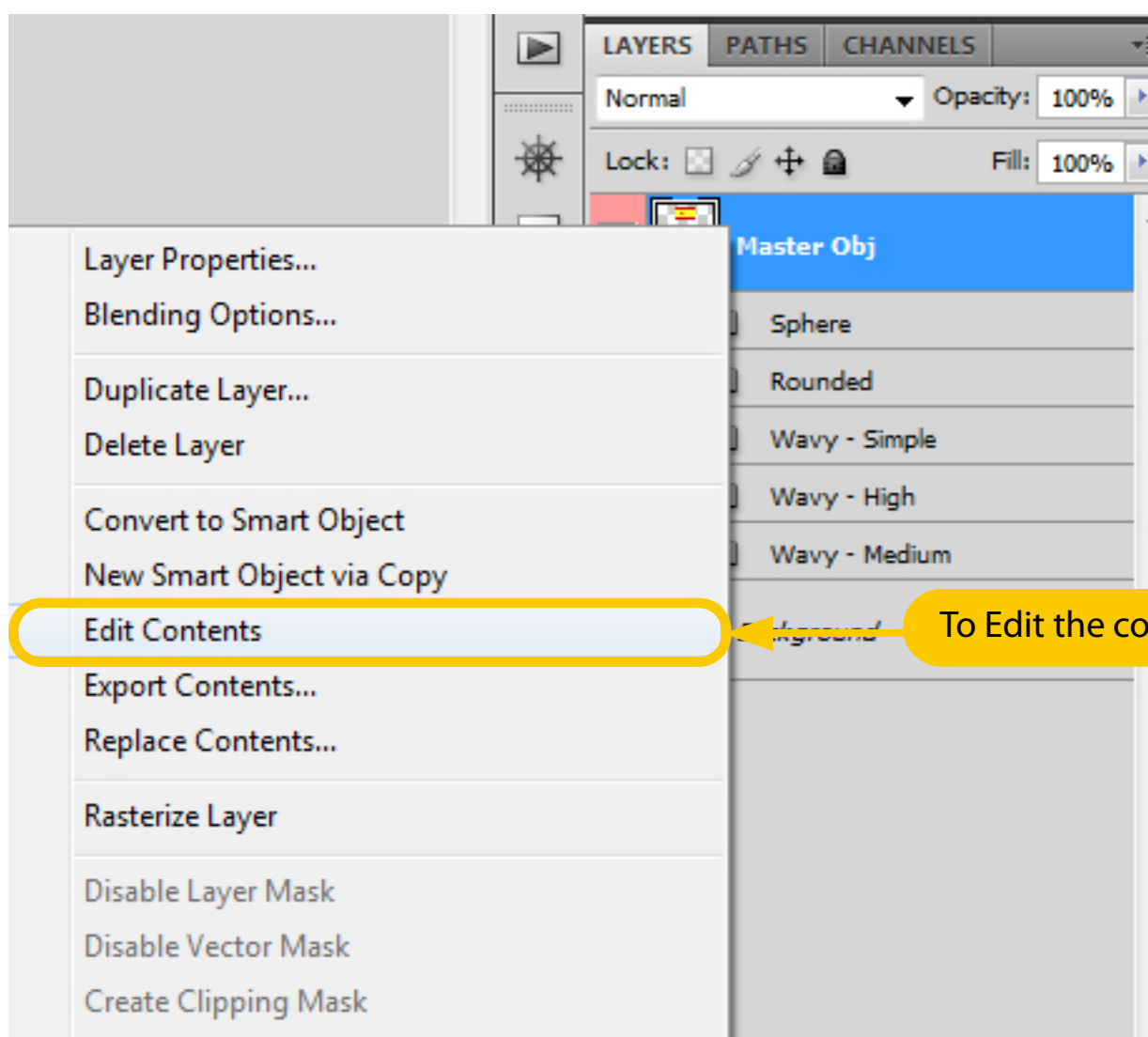

After downloading and unzipping folder “Artbees Flag Creator”, open “Flag creator.psd”.

As you see, there are bunch of “United Nations” flag styles on the page as a sample. Right in the layers panel there is a red label smart layer called “Master”. Once you update this layer with your own image, all flaggy styles will update as well. **Right-click** on the “Master” layer. Select “Edit Contents”. A new .psb document opens up. Paste your desired flag or any other artwork in here and fit it in document. **Save** the document and **Close**. Now back to “Flag creator.psd” you see all styles are updated.

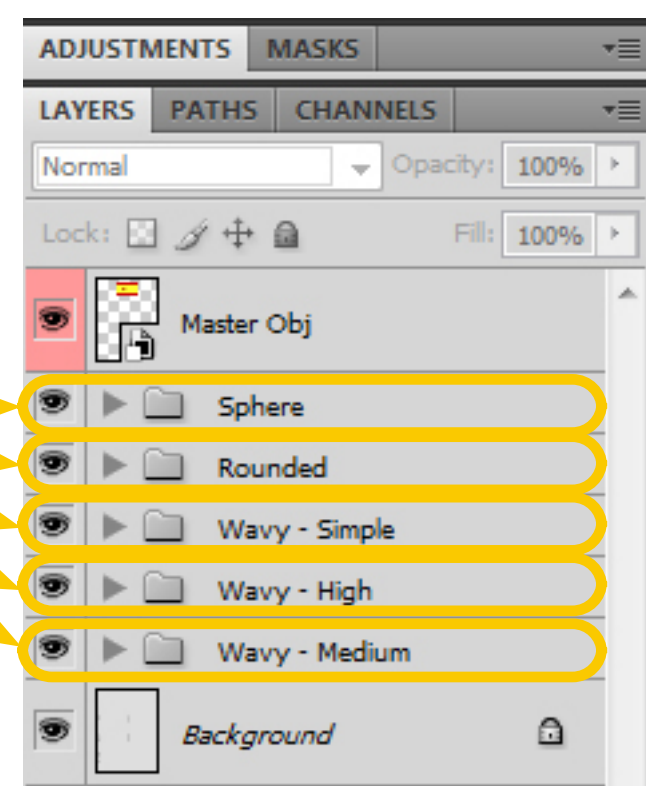


To Edit the content of smart layer, select this option.

Finish! Now you have your own flaggy style icons. Actually you have 5 styles, each embedded in a **Layer Group**. You can find them easily in the layers panel. Each is named and well-organized. 5 Layer Groups for 5 Styles.

These are Layer Groups, Each for a unique style



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Very important thing to remember!

You can use flags in many ways but if you're going to drag and drop it in other file(s), Make sure you have already merged the group. How? It's easy. Just select the desired **Layer Group**, **Right-click** then choose **Merge Group** from context menu. Then drag it and drop where ever you want.

If you want to remove shadows when using your flags, Open the specific group, delete a layer named **"Shadow"** (**Yellow label**) and Merge group. (Right-Click + Merge Group)

Delete this layer if you don't want to include shadows
