### **Comparing Workstation to Fusion**

- Like Workstation, a Type 2 Hypervisor
- Also from VMware
- Fusion Runs on Apple Mac
- Fusion and Workstation are Sister Solutions

### **Comparing Workstation to Parallels Desktop**

- Parallels Desktop is a Type 2 Hypervisor, Like Workstation
- Available for Mac Only
- Parallels Offered the First Mac Virtualization Solution
- Minority Stake of Parallels Owned by Cisco
- Parallels Also Offers Hosting and Cloud Solutions

### **Comparing Workstation to Oracle VM**

- A Type 2 Hypervisor, Like Workstation
- Previously Known as Sun Virtual Box
- An Open Source Virtualization Solution
- Runs On Windows, Mac, Linux, and Solaris
- Not as Feature-Rich as Workstation
- VMs Aren't Compatible with Workstation or vSphere





### Comparing Workstation to VMware ESXi / vSphere

- A Type 1 Hypervisor That Runs Directly on a Physical Server
- vSphere (A Datacenter Solution) vs. Workstation (A Desktop Solution)





### Comparing Workstation to Microsoft Hyper-V

- A Type 1 Hypervisor That Runs Directly on a Physical Server (Or In Windows 8 on a Desktop or Laptop)
- Hyper-V, in Windows Server 2012, is a Datacenter Solution
- Client Hyper-V is a Desktop Solution
- Both Run Only on Windows
- Neither Are as Feature-Rich as Workstation
